

Without Dentures Abnormal Facial Proportions

Bite collapse can occur when teeth are lost. An extreme situation occurs when all teeth are lost. The lower third of facial height is dramatically lost causing the lips and cheeks to lose support and increase wrinkles.

With Dentures Normal Facial Proportions

Normal facial proportions are maintained when a person's teeth are replaced correctly. The lips and cheeks are properly supported creating your optimal appearance.

When Dentures are not regularly relined it can cause:

You Need a Reline!

Dental Professionals recommend a denture reline every 2-3 years in order to make up for ridge loss, even if the denture is not loose.

Causes for Relines Include:

- Weight Loss
- Change in Medications
- More than 2 years since they were made

- Red/sore areas in the corner of the
